Green Practices

(Policy since the foundation of Ideales Resort - 2005)



For all of us, the environment is what is most important. In our best efforts to protect it, we have invested and adopted **policies** of environmental responsibility.

Power saving :

- All electrical appliances (except from the fridge) have power supply only when inserting the card (attached to the villa key) in the special slot next to the main entrance of the villa. Upon leaving the villa all devices are turned off so as to save energy.
- All windows in the villas are double glazed for insulation reducing the consumption of cooling and heating.
- For lighting we only use energy saving light bulbs which are recycled after their use. At the main entrance of each villa there are motion detector lights. The air-conditioning system operates only when the main door and all the windows are closed.

Water saving :

- All villas have hot water by solar water heaters.
- In all villas there are water pressure reducers and dual flush cisterns in all bathrooms.
- As part of our Green Household, we change bed linen, towels and pool towels 2 times a week so as to reduce unnecessary laundry services and the consequent environmental impact (water waste, detergent and energy).
- Our eco pool[®] (Piscines Ideales the eco pool[®]) conforms to all hygiene and safety rules and regulations. Our advanced systems and ecological products, which have replaced the technologies of the past, allow you to enjoy the pool, saving useful resources (i.e. water and energy).
- The gardens of Ideales Resort have plants that are very resistant to weather conditions and thrive in the region of Kefalonia. They need little watering and provide natural shadow out of the villas. Moreover, there is no lawn that requires huge amounts of water for its maintenance.

Recycling and Waste Reduction :

- We urge all our Guests to recycle the waste by using the specially placed bin in the kitchen for paper, glass, metal and plastic. All waste generated by Ideales Resort is sorted to ensure much of what is thrown away is recycled.
- We use compost bins for organic waste.
- We kindly request all our Guests to minimize the use of plastic bags and of inflatable items (which are not recyclable) during their holidays.

The aromatic plants produce and exude aromatic substances, which are used in making perfumes, in cooking and in the food, pharmaceutical and liquor industries.













Citrus fruit trees

Citrus is a genus of flowering trees and shrubs in the rue family, Rutaceae. Plants in the genus produce citrus fruits, including important crops like oranges, lemons, grapefruit, pomelo, mandarins and limes. They are also good sources of vitamin C and flavonoids.













Fruit trees

A fruit tree is a tree which bears fruit to be consumed. All trees that are flowering plants produce fruit, which are the ripened ovaries of flowers containing one or more seeds.



Our small habitat – Kefalonia Fauna

Our policies of environmental responsibility proudly also include our efforts for the protection of the local fauna.

The fauna in Kefalonia is surprisingly rich and the island has a variety of **wildlife** including **foxes**, **hares**, **weasels**, **martens** and **hedgehogs**. **Wild horses** are common on the sides of Mount Ainos, but the sightings are rare. There are also **snakes**, but they are mostly harmless. A rare and protected species of **seals** live on the inaccessible shores of the island and of course the well-known **Loggerhead sea turtle Caretta-Caretta**.

The rich fauna is mostly found on **Mount Ainos**, the second highest mountain in the Greek islands, reaching to its highest peak (Soros) the altitude of 1.628 meters. It is also **one of the 10 National Greek Reserves**, a refuge for migratory birds and mammals, the ideal habitat for rare species of flowers, shrubs and herbs. Its slopes are covered with trees of a dark green species that grow only here (the abies cephalonica).





A few important notes on the well-known Caretta-Caretta:

- The Caretta-Caretta (or Loggerhead sea turtle) is a rare sea turtle that lives in the Mediterranean Sea and particularly along the coasts of Kefalonia and Zakynthos.
- ✓ It can grow to considerable size, with a weight up to 140kg. Despite their size, these turtles can swim very fast, thanks to their large and rigid flippers on the front and to the rear. However, on the mainland they become extremely vulnerable and slow because, unlike other turtles, the Caretta-Caretta turtle can not retract into its carapace to hide.
- ✓ It always breeds on the same beach where it is born, and for this reason it is important that the nesting beach is kept as untouched as possible. The nesting period is from June to August. The eggs are small and soft and do not break when dropped into the hole. The nest contains about 120 eggs that hatch usually 50 days after the laying. Eggs are protected by the sand and kept warm by the sun. Usually about 60% of all eggs hatch and young turtles move towards the sea following the horizon and the reflection of the moonlight on sea. Only a small percentage survives the physical obstacles on the beach and the lights of restaurants and bars often confuse young turtles.
- ✓ Some of the beaches of Kefalonia are highly protected during the breeding season of the turtle, including Mounda Beach near Skala, Trapezaki Beach, Minies Beach and the area near the airport.

Likely to see while in Kefalonia:

- ✓ Hedgehogs sometimes when they try to cross the road.
- The land turtles are too many and they are often seen on the side of the road as well. If you see them please protect them by helping them to pass on the safe side of the road.
- ✓ Wild horses, foxes and goats on Mount Ainos.
- Of course let us not forget that while being closer to nature you may come across with more "disturbing" small creatures like wasps, bees, flies, mosquitoes, butterflies, lizards, spiders and ants. We are using natural, not harmful removal methods so as not to "disturb" you during your holidays.



Kefalonia is full of beautiful landscapes and the best way to explore them is through a **long walk** or an **adventurous hike**. Discover the unique nature and wildlife of the island; wander around on ancient paths and get to know the rich heritage of the **"Beauty of the lonian**" on foot.

We would like to encourage you, while on holidays, to be **closer** to nature, observe its wonders and protect each species that you will possibly come across with. Benefit from the relaxing natural sounds and images that Kefalonia's flora and fauna has to offer. Respect and protect the flora and the local habitat and please do not participate in any activities that could possibly harm them.
